
MANDATORY CLE REQUIREMENT INFORMATION

Effective May 1, 2023



Compliance Cycle - The lawyer's first compliance cycle runs from July 1 following admission to the Bar and ends one year later, on June 30.

On or before July 31st each year, each lawyer or paralegal practitioner subject to MCLE requirements *must file a Certificate of Compliance* with the <u>Supreme Court Board of Continuing</u> <u>Legal Education</u> appropriately evidencing the lawyer's or paralegal practitioner's completion of accredited CLE ending the preceding 30th day of June.

Each lawyer or paralegal practitioner shall pay a *filing fee of \$10* when filing the Certificate of Compliance. Any lawyer or paralegal practitioner who fails to complete the MCLE requirement by the June 30th deadline or fails to file by the July 31st deadline will be assessed a *\$100 late fee*.

*If the New Lawyer Training Program will not be completed by June 30 of the current compliance cycle, the attorney needs to comply with the Regular 12 Hour MCLE Requirements and use the NLTP completion for the following compliance cycle.

Regular 12 Hour MCLE Requirements - UCJA Rule 14-404

- 12 hours of Accredited CLE before the end of the one-year compliance cycle. At least 6 of the CLE hours must be Verified (Live) CLE, which may include any combination of In-person, Remote Group CLE or Verified E-CLE.
- The remaining 6 CLE hours may include Elective (Self-Study) or Verified (Live) CLE.
- 1 of the CLE hours must be Ethics.
- 1 of the CLE hours must be Professionalism and Civility.
